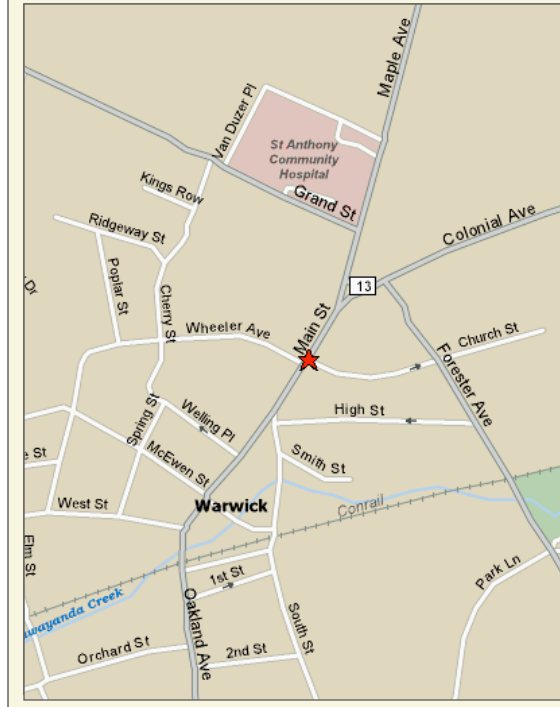




THE OLD SCHOOL BAPTIST MEETING HOUSE

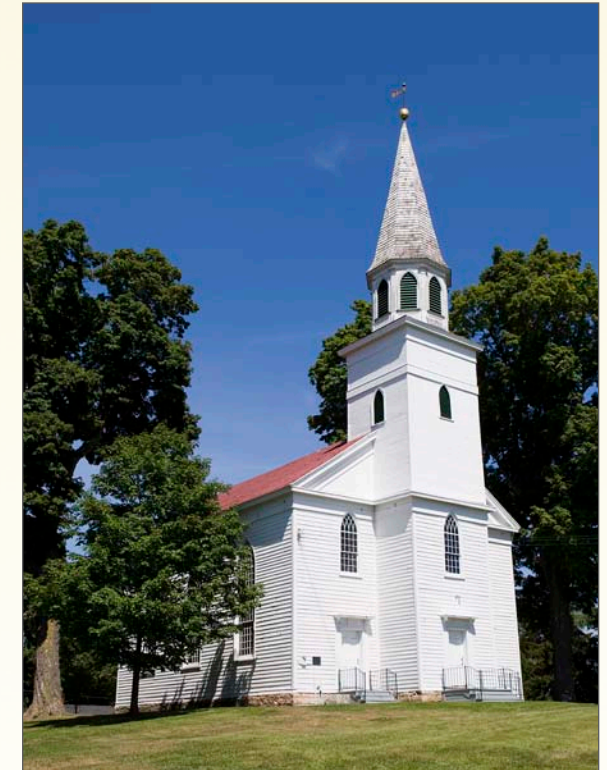

THE WARWICK HISTORICAL SOCIETY'S MEETING HOUSE

Whether you are planning a summer, spring, fall or winter wedding, you will experience a truly memorable ceremony in the Warwick Historical Society's charming Old School Baptist Meeting House. The Meeting House has been an icon of this historic part of the lower Hudson River Valley since 1810 and the site for many weddings and other ceremonies. You may have seen it in the film, "In and Out" starring Kevin Kline.

Magnificently situated in the center of this historic village, the Meeting House is the perfect setting for a sun-filled daytime or candlelit evening ceremony.

Constructed in 1810 the Meeting House was designed by Deacon John Foght and built by Azariah Ketchum. It is sited in what is now Lewis Park which is perfect for a tented wedding reception.

The Meeting House originally seated about 500 people in both the ground floor and gallery running around three sides. Today's regulations limit occupancy to 200. Deacon John Foght carved the lovely golden dove with an olive branch in its beak--"Emblem of Peace" - which is poised above the unique and beautiful "wineglass" pulpit.

If you are looking for an alternative to a town hall ceremony consider this beautiful and historic Meeting House
